ARTICLE 1: ORGANISER

The Automobile Club de l'Ouest (ci-après « ACO »), association governed by the French law of 1901, registered under SIREN number 775 652 316, with its registered office at Circuit des 24 Heures, 72019 Le Mans Cedex 2, (hereinafter referred to as the 'Organiser') is organizing, from Thursday, 18 December 2025 at 04:00 p.m. to Thursday, 25 December 2025 at 00:00 a.m. (Paris time) (hereinafter the « Contest Period »), a contest named "Golden Ticket" (hereinafter the « Contest »).

ARTICLE 2: PARTICIPANTS

The Contest, which is free of charge and without obligation to purchase, is open to any natural person who has purchased at least one "2 days practice" ticket for the 24 Hours of Le Mans 2026 (hereinafter the "Participant(s)"), excluding employees and directors of the Organiser and its subsidiaries, its suppliers and service providers and people related to the staff of the Organiser or its subsidiaries.

The Organiser specifies that a minor may only take part in the Contest after obtaining the authorisation of his/her parents or legal representative. A verification of the parents or legal representative of the minor is required for the minor to participate in the Contest, as well as when collecting the prizes.

A minor who is unable to benefit from the prize he has won because of its nature may select the adult of his/her choice as beneficiary.

ARTICLE 3: TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

Throughout the Contest Period, the Participant will be able to access the Contest page either by visiting the official Instagram page "@24heuresdumans", the official Facebook page "24 Hours of Le Mans", or through an e-mail sent to purchasers of at least one "2 days practice" ticket who have agreed to receive in the ACO Club Newsletter sent by the Organiser to all ACO members who have agreed to receive promotional offers following their purchase.

Participants will have access to the competition via:

- A link in the stories and in the posts made on the aforementioned pages, which will be dedicated to the Contest;
- A link that will be sent by e-mail, provided that they have expressed an interest and agreed to receive promotional offers following the purchase of their ticket, to inform them about the Contest

Participants may also access the Contest by means of link provided by a third party.

Participant must click on the link redirecting them to a dedicated platform, allowing them to access the Contest, presented as a form.

Once redirected to the Contest platform, Participant must then enter his first name, surname, e-mail address and all information relating to his ticket purchase that may be required via the form on the Contest platform. Participant may take note of the Contest rules via a link diffused on the Contest page. He must then tick, after taking note of the Contest rules, the box "I accept the contest rules" to participate, then click on the "I participate" box.

Only one entry per e-mail address per day will be accepted.

ARTICLE 4: PERIOD OF THE CONTEST

The Contest will be open from Thursday, 18 December 2025 at 04:00 p.m. to Thursday, 25 December 2025 at 00:00 a.m. (Paris time).

ARTICLE 5: WINNER DESIGNATION

Once the Contest Period has ended, an electronic draw will be held on 06 January 2026 to select the winner of the Contest (hereinafter referred to as 'The Winner').

The Winner will be contacted by e-mail at the address provided on the ticket purchase form by 13 January 2025 at the latest.

The Winner, after being informed of the draw result, must come forward before 20 January 2026 in order to claim its prize. If he fail to do so, the prize will be re-drawn.

If a response is not received within this period and/or if the Winner does not meet the general conditions of use for each prize mentioned in article 6 of these Contest rules, the Winner will be unable to benefit from the prize.

In this case, the prize will be re-drawn and a new draw will be held amongst the other Participants. The prize will be re-drawn under the same conditions until it has been awarded.

ARTICLE 6: PRIZES

The prizes are as follows:

- Two (2) hospitality passes (Le Mans Spirit Club offer) valid for both Practice days
 - Value including VAT: €733 per day = €1,466
- Visit to the Ferrari AF Corse pit during one of these two days for the winner and their guest
 - Value including VAT: Not valuable as not commercially available

The Participants will have to meet the general conditions of use for each prize (e.g., size, age...) in order to benefit from the prize.

These prizes may not be contested by the Winner in any way, nor may they be exchanged for cash or replaced or exchanged for any reason whatsoever.

Furthermore, no claim may be made in the event of a Winner being unable to benefit from his/her prize because of the contact details provided when registering for the Contest being incorrect or inaccurate.

ARTICLE 7: AWARDING OF PRIZES

The prize "Hospitality passes" will be sent to the Winners by e-mail (e-tickets), as soon as they are available.

The prize "Visit to the Ferrari AF Corse pit" will be awarded to the Winner when attending the 2026 Le Mans 24 Hours. The Winner must present himself to the Organiser's staff with proof of identity, who will then arrange for the prize to be delivered.

By mutual agreement, the prizes may be collected from the Organiser's head office within one month of receipt of the e-mail informing of the availability of the prizes.

ARTICLE 8: PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA

Personal data collected in the frame of the Contest is processed in accordance with the law of 6 January 1978, referred to as the "Data Freedom Act", and in accordance with Regulation No. 2016/679, referred to as the General Data Protection Regulation. Participants are informed that personal data is necessary for their participation to be taken into account.

It may also be used by the Organiser to send commercial information and offers, when the Participant has expressly agreed to this when registering by ticking the box provided for this purpose, with Participants remaining free to unsubscribe from newsletters sent in this way at any time.

This storage period for this data is three (3) years.

All of the Contest's Participants have the right to access, rectify and delete their data, the right to limit the processing of their data and the right to the portability of their data. ARTICLE 9: RESPONSIBILITY

The Organiser cannot be held responsible if, due to force majeure or any other cause beyond its control, the Contest must be modified, postponed, extended, shortened or cancelled.

In all cases, the Organiser reserves the right to extend the Duration of the Contest and to postpone any announced date.

Additions or modifications to these rules may be published on the Contest page during the Contest. They will be considered as amendments to these rules.

ARTICLE 10: ACCEPTANCE OF THE RULES

The mere fact of participating implies full acceptance of these rules in their entirety. If one or more of the provisions of these rules are declared null and void or inapplicable, the other provisions will remain in full force and effect.

The rules will be sent, free of charge, to anyone who requests them at the following address: ACO - Service Communication - Circuit des 24 Heures - 72019 Le Mans Cedex 2.

Postage costs (at the current third-class rate) when requesting the rules as well as Internet connection costs (only for people using an account debited by connection time) will be reimbursed on simple request sent, within a maximum of 2 weeks from the end of the Contest, to the ACO - Service Communication - Circuit des 24 Heures - 72019 Le Mans Cedex 2.

The Organiser reserves the right to take legal action against anyone who has defrauded or attempted to defraud this Contest. It will not incur any liability of any kind with regard to the Participants as a result of any fraud that may be committed.

In the event of a violation by a Participant, the Organiser reserves the right to automatically exclude the latter from participating, without the latter being able to claim any compensation.

ARTICLE 11: DISPUTES

These rules are subject to French law.

Any dispute must first be reported to the Organiser, and an attempt must be made to reach an amicable agreement.

No dispute will be admissible one month after the date of the announcement of the results. In the absence of an amicable agreement, any dispute relating to these rules will be submitted to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Court located in Le Mans, which has been declared competent according to the legislation in force.
